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KEVAL SOUND is a sole proprietorship owned by SYED ZOHEB in India.

KEVAL SOUND is built for creators, producers, brands, and listeners who want music that feels original, usable, and clearly licensed. We are creating a platform where people can discover exclusive music, buy licensed tracks, access unique samples, and listen through KEVAL RADIO.

What We Do

KEVAL SOUND is a digital music and sound platform focused on three connected experiences:

- Exclusive music licensing for creators, filmmakers, editors, agencies, brands, podcasters, game makers, and social media creators.
- KEVAL RADIO, a listening experience for discovering streamable music through curated radio-style playback.
- Exclusive samples for music producers who want loops, one-shots, vocals, stems, and sounds that are not reused endlessly across the internet.

Our goal is simple: help creators find music that sounds fresh, feels useful, and comes with clearer rights than random free downloads or overused stock tracks.

Why We Started

A lot of creators face the same problem: the music available online is either too expensive, too generic, too overused, or too confusing to license.

KEVAL SOUND exists because originality should be easier to access. A creator should be able to find a track, understand what they are allowed to do with it, pay securely, download the file, and keep a license record for future proof.

For producers, we want samples to feel special again. If a sample is sold as exclusive, it should not remain endlessly available to thousands of other producers.

For listeners, KEVAL RADIO is our way of turning the catalog into discovery: a place to hear unique music, regional sounds, fusion ideas, and experimental tracks in a simple listening experience.

What Makes KEVAL SOUND Different

KEVAL SOUND is designed around exclusivity, clarity, and affordability.

Here are a few things we are building toward:

- One song, one buyer for exclusive music purchases.
- License certificates after eligible music purchases.
- Downloadable high-quality files, including WAV where available.
- Owner, buyer, collector, or curator display for eligible purchased tracks.
- KEVAL RADIO for discovering streamable catalog music.

- Exclusive sample purchases where the sample can be removed from public sale after purchase.
- Clearer separation between listening access, download access, commercial usage rights, and ownership-style display.
- A music marketplace made for creators who need practical rights, not confusing legal guesswork.

How Music Rights Work on KEVAL SOUND

Music rights can be complicated, so KEVAL SOUND tries to make the buying experience clearer.

When a user buys an eligible music track on KEVAL SOUND, the buyer receives the rights described in the applicable product page, checkout page, license certificate, and Terms of Service.

In general, an exclusive music purchase means:

- The purchased track is intended to be locked or removed from future purchase by other buyers.
- The buyer receives a license certificate or purchase record.
- The buyer may receive a WAV file or another available file format.
- The buyer may be shown as the owner, buyer, collector, or curator of that track inside KEVAL SOUND.
- The buyer can use the music only within the rights granted by the applicable license certificate.

Unless a specific license certificate or separate written agreement clearly says otherwise, a KEVAL SOUND music purchase does not automatically transfer full copyright ownership, publishing rights, composer rights, moral rights, public performance rights, collection society rights, or every possible music right.

KEVAL SOUND may retain the rights needed to host, store, stream, preview, display, promote, protect, track, and make the track available through KEVAL SOUND, KEVAL Player, KEVAL RADIO, previews, dashboards, and support systems.

This means a purchased song may still remain streamable through KEVAL RADIO or KEVAL Player if KEVAL SOUND has retained or secured the required streaming rights.

How Sample Rights Work

KEVAL SOUND also offers samples for producers. These may include loops, one-shots, stems, vocals, sound packs, and other production-ready sounds.

When a sample is sold as exclusive, we aim to remove or lock it from future purchase so another producer cannot buy the same sample from KEVAL SOUND after it has been sold.

Sample buyers receive the usage rights described in the applicable product page, sample license, checkout page, and Terms of Service.

Unless the sample license clearly allows it, buyers should not resell, redistribute, share, repackage, or upload raw sample files as standalone assets.

Rights Clearance and Catalog Standards

KEVAL SOUND is intended to list music and samples that we own, control, create, commission, license, or are otherwise authorized to provide.

Before assets go live, our goal is to review them for quality, originality, metadata accuracy, and rights suitability. We want buyers to feel confident that the music or sample they are purchasing is being offered through a platform that takes rights seriously.

If a rights issue, copyright concern, or ownership question is reported, we may review the asset, pause delivery, update records, contact involved parties, remove the asset, or take other action according to our Terms of Service.

KEVAL RADIO

KEVAL RADIO is the listening side of KEVAL SOUND.

It gives listeners a way to discover streamable catalog music through radio-style playback, stations, moods, genres, regions, and curated discovery. KEVAL RADIO access is for listening only. It does not grant the right to download raw files or use streamed music in videos, ads, podcasts, games, films, client work, or commercial projects.

Commercial use requires a valid purchase, license certificate, or separate written license.

For Creators and Brands

KEVAL SOUND helps creators and brands find music that can be used with more confidence.

Creators may use KEVAL SOUND to find music for:

- YouTube videos.
- Instagram and short-form content.
- Podcasts.
- Films and documentaries.
- Ads and brand campaigns.
- Games and digital products.
- Client work and agency projects.

The exact usage rights depend on the license attached to the purchased asset, so buyers should always review their license certificate before publishing or monetizing content.

For Producers

Producers can use KEVAL SOUND to discover samples that help their work sound different.

Instead of everyone using the same recycled sounds, KEVAL SOUND focuses on exclusive sample access and unique production material. Our aim is to help producers build music with a stronger identity.

For Listeners

Listeners can use KEVAL RADIO to discover music from the KEVAL SOUND catalog.

The listening experience is built around discovery: new sounds, regional flavor, experimental ideas, global influences, and music that may not feel like the same repeated playlist everyone else is hearing.
